Gypsum Sand	Knolls, Toole County
Oolitic Sand	Stansbury Island, Toole County
Minerals: Topaz, Red Beryl, Amethyst, Garnet, Pseudobrookite, Bixbyite, Opal, Hematite	Topaz Mountain, Juab County
Feldspar, Bixbyite, Rutile, Amethyst	Marysvale, Piute County
Geodes	Dugway Geode Beds, Juab county
Wonderstone	Vernon Hills, Toole County
Birdseye Marble	Manti-La Sal National Forest, Utah County
Banded calcite	Mount Nebo, Juab County
Volcanic breccia, basalt	Sunstone Knoll, Millard County
Obsidian	Black Rock Desert, Millard County
Smoky Quartz, Feldspar	Mineral Mountains, Beaver County
Jasper, Agate, Chert, Petrified Wood	Capital Reef National Park and Cainsville, Wayne County
